**(A) O:** Anterior superior iliac spine (ASIS)

**I:** Proximal, medial shaft of the tibia, *Pes anserinus* tendon.

**(B) O:** Lateral condyle of tibia, proximal lateral surface of tibia, interosseous membrane.

**I:** Medial cuneiform, base of the first metatarsal.

**(C) O:** Cartilage of fifth, sixth, and seventh ribs, and xiphoid process.



**I:** Pubic crest, pubic symphysis.

**(D) O:** Common extensor tendon from lateral epicondyle of humerus.

**I:** Middle and distal phalanges of second through fifth fingers.

**(E) O:** Lateral supracondylar ridge of humerus.

**(F) O:** Short Head: Coracoid process of scapula. Long Head: Supraglenoid tubercle of scapula.

**I:** Tuberosity of radius and aponeurosis of the biceps brachii.

**(G) O:** Lower eight ribs.

**I:** Anterior part of the iliac crest, abdominal aponeurosis at linea alba.

**(H) O:** Posterior surface of radius and ulna, deep to extensors.





**I:** Distal phalange of thumb.











**(J)** O: Bodies and transverse processes of lumbar vertebrae.






